DARIO PETRI

Short Biography

Dario Petri received the M.Sc. degree (summa cum laude) and the Ph.D. degree in Electronics Engineering from the University of Padova, Italy, in 1986 and 1990, respectively. From 1990 to 1992 he was with the Department of "Electronics and Information Engineering" of the same university as an assistant professor. In 1992 he joined the University of Perugia, Italy, as an associate professor, where he was the chair of undergraduate and graduate degree study programs in Information Engineering since 1999. In the same year he has been elevated to full professorship of Measurement and Electronic Instrumentation. In 2002 he joined the Department of "Information Engineering and Computer Science" of the University of Trento, Italy, where he was the chair of the International Ph.D. School in "Information and Communication Technology" from 2004 to 2007. At present he is the chair of undergraduate and graduate degree study programs in Information Engineering of the University of Trento.

He has chaired the Italy Chapter of the IEEE Instrumentation and Measurement Society from 2006 to 2010. Currently he is the Vice Chair of the IEEE Italy Section, which gather almost 5000 researchers from Italian Universities and Companies in the area of Electrical and Information Engineering. Also, he has been a Co-founder and General Chair of the Ph.D Schol "International Measurement University" (IMU) of the IEEE Instrumentation & Measurement Society and General Chair of various international Conferences and Workshops. He has chaired the Italian research line on "Measurement for the Information Society" of the Italian Society of Electrical and Electronic Measurement (GMEE), from 2002 to 2008 and the Italian Ph.D. School on "Measurement and Information Society" of the same Society from 2002 to 2005. He is currently the Vice-chair of the GMEE, which gather researchers from Universities, Metrological Institutes and Companies in the field of measurement and instrumentation.

Dario Petri is an Associate Editor of the IEEE Transactions on Instrumentation and Measurement and a Fellow member of the IEEE.

Dr. Petri is an author of over two hundred papers published in international journals or in proceedings of peer reviewed international conferences. Research activities of Dario Petri are in the area of measurement science and technology, and they are focused on data acquisition systems design and testing, embedded systems design and characterization, uncertainty evaluation methods, statistical inference methods and application of digital signal processing to measurement problems, measurement for quality management systems.
